UNIFORM SEPTEMBER 2017

Boys - Everyday school uniform

The uniform consists of:

- A black blazer with a school badge.
- A white shirt. This may be long or short-sleeved, according to preference and/or weather conditions. If any item is to be worn for warmth under the shirt, it must be white in colour.
- A clip on school tie.
- Plain black or grey (not light grey) trousers. Note: Jeans or canvas trousers are totally unacceptable, as are trousers of any kind of denim material. Trousers must not be "skinny" or too tight. No embroidery or logo should be on the trousers. Belts, if desired, should be black in colour.
- Grey, black or navy socks. PE socks are not allowed as everyday school wear.
- A plain grey or black v neck jumper or a navy v neck sweatshirt with or without a school badge can be purchased from our uniform supplier.
- 'Hoodies' **are not** to be worn under blazers and neither are jumpers/cardigans with designer labels or sports labels.

Boys - Footwear

- Plain flat, black shoes of leather (or leather substitute) and substantial. Black is the only colour and should be the only colour on the shoe. There must be no logos.
- Boots are not allowed, except in particularly inclement weather conditions (very icy/snowy).
- No training shoes, pumps or plimsolls are allowed. In particular converse or similar footwear must not be worn.

Boys PE Kit

The same high standards in P.E. kit are insisted upon as for school uniform. Clothing with designer or sports logos is unacceptable.

Compulsory

- Plain navy and yellow T-shirt with or without SJF badge and name of pupil are available from our uniform suppliers or alternatively a plain navy T-shirt.
- Plain navy shorts, with or without a school badge and are available from our uniform supplier.
- Plain navy long socks or white or black ankle sports socks.
- Plain navy and yellow hoodie with or without SJF badge and name of pupil are available from our uniform suppliers or alternatively a plain navy sweatshirt.
- Training shoes (not fashion trainers or pumps).
- Football boots.
- Shin Pads.
- Gum Shields for Rugby.

Optional

- Rugby Shirt: Navy with yellow panels,
- Plain navy jogging trousers. Can be purchased with school logo from our uniform suppliers.
- Plain navy base layer top.
- Plain navy base layer leggings. Only to be worn under school shorts.

If pupils wish to change into trainers in order to play games/football on the yard at break and lunchtime, they may do so but they must change their footwear back to school shoes before they return to the classroom

Girls - Everyday school uniform

The uniform consists of:

- A black blazer with a school badge or a black fitted blazer with a school badge from our uniform suppliers.
- A white shirt with a collar and top button (not a blouse). This may be long or short-sleeved, according
 to preference and/or weather conditions. If any item is to be worn for warmth under the shirt, it must
 be white in colour. The shirt must not be of a 'fitted' type which cannot be tucked into skirt/trousers.
- A clip on school tie.
- Year 7 Pleated check grey skirt available from our uniform suppliers. (Other year groups may wear this skirt).
- Year 8 to 11 An A line grey skirt available with an SJFCC logo from our uniform suppliers
 or a pleated plain grey skirt. Note: Skirt should be knee length and not excessively tight. It
 must not be made from jersey or other similar materials.
- Plain black trousers. Note: Jeans or canvas trousers are totally unacceptable, as are trousers
 of any kind of denim material. Trousers must not be "skinny" or too tight, nor have exposed
 zips. Trousers should allow the shirt to be tucked into them. Trousers are available with the
 SJFCC logo from our uniform suppliers. Belts, if desired, should be black in colour.
- Plain black or white socks or black tights. PE socks are not allowed as everyday school wear.
- A plain grey or black v neck jumper or a navy v neck sweatshirt with or without a school badge can be purchased from our uniform suppliers.
- If required a navy or black Hijab can be purchased from our uniform suppliers.
- 'Hoodies' are not to be worn under blazers and neither are jumpers/cardigans with designer labels or sports labels

Girls - Footwear

- Plain flat, black shoes of leather (or leather substitute) and substantial. Heel height is **no more** than one inch. Black is the **only** colour and should be the **only** colour on the shoe. There must be no logos.
- Boots are not allowed, except in particularly inclement weather conditions (very icy/snowy).
- No training shoes, pumps or plimsolls are allowed. In particular converse or similar footwear must not be worn.

Girls PE Kit

The same high standards in P.E. kit are insisted upon as for school uniform. Clothing with designer or sports labels is unacceptable.

Compulsory

- Plain navy and yellow T-shirt (SJF badge and name of pupil) or plain navy T-shirt.
- Plain navy shorts, with or without a school badge and are available from our uniform supplier. (No cycling shorts/leggings).
- Plain Navy skort with the school badge are available from our uniform supplier.
- Plain navy long socks or White ankle sports socks.
- Plain navy and yellow hoodie with or without SJF badge and name of pupil are available from our uniform suppliers or alternatively a plain navy sweatshirt.
- Training shoes (not fashion trainers or pumps).

Optional

- Rugby shirt: Navy with yellow panels.
- Plain navy jogging trouser. Can be purchased with school logo from our uniform suppliers.
- Plain navy base layer top.
- Plain navy base layer leggings. Only to be worn under school shorts or skort.

If pupils wish to change into trainers in order to play games/football on the yard at break and lunchtime, they may do so but they must change their footwear back to school shoes before they return to the classroom.
